Responsibilities Include:

- Recruit, support, and facilitate the Youth Leadership Corps (YLC) Black Girls Rock (BGR) and other Youth prevention programming
- Conduct outreach to youth serving organizations in the Greater Lowell area
- Implement education training to youth serving providers on sexual violence and social justice
- Provide psychoeducation and advocacy with and for youth, survivors, predominantly youth of color, refugee and immigrants, and LGBTQ/T
- Collaborate and work with Hope Prevents team
- Collaborate and work with Survivor Services team around creative intervention for youth survivors
- Conduct needs assessments and evaluation for Youth programming development and implementation
- Support web-based referrals and/or chat services project
- Other related duties as determined by direct supervisor

Basic Requirements:

- Bachelor's Degree in related field or equivalent work experience (e.g., social work, sociology, psychology, community organizing)
- 1-3 years' experience working with youth and/or adults who work with youth
- Previous youth organizing experience in training, outreach and mentorship
- Experience working at a youth serving organization or in a prevention program
- Experience working with and/or developing and implementing culturally relevant programs and services for historically underserved populations (e.g., youth of color, LGBTQ/T, refugees and immigrants, youth and young adults, people with disabilities, etc.)
- Excellent presentations skill and communication skills both verbal/written
- Must be RCC trained or willing to be trained within three months of employment
- Ability to travel in Lowell, within state, and work evenings and weekends as necessary
